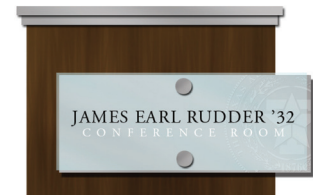


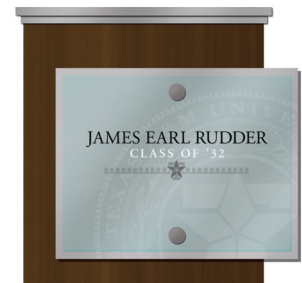
Room Naming Opportunities:

Donor names will be visible inside large rooms and near their entrances, while smaller spaces will recognize donors only near the entrance.

Room Interior

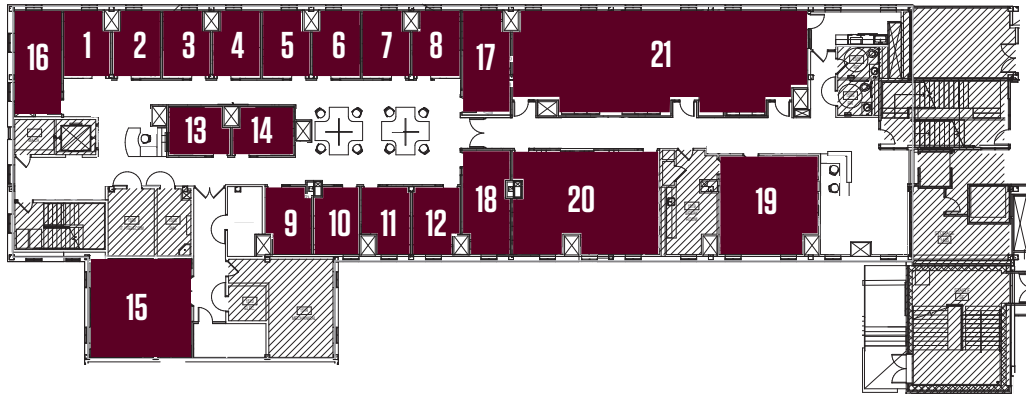
OPTIONS FOR DIRECTING YOUR GIFT:
