

## A Tradition of Unity

The mission of BUILD is to unite the Texas A&M University student body through a physically demanding, large-scale service project each fall.

- The **12-for-12 Project** (2014-2016) outfitted 12 facilities in honor of the 12 Aggies who passed away in the 1999 Bonfire tragedy.
- The 5-for-5 Project (2017) was a one-year campaign to dedicate 5 TAMCs to 5 Aggie veterans recognized by the Texas Aggies Go to War organization for their contributions to the Allied victory in the Battle of the Bulge.
- The Fallen Aggie Hero Project (2018present) dedicates TAMCs in honor of Aggie veterans who gave their lives while serving their country on or after 9/11.



Help us remove Barriers for BUILD

BUILD is a Texas A&M University student organization and 501(c)(3) nonprofit that converts 40-foot shipping containers into fully-functional, portable, modern medical facilities that are shipped

domestically and internationally to communities in need. Over the past decade, over 10,000 student volunteers have outfitted and shipped 37 medical facilities that impact hundreds of thousands of lives around the world.

These clinics contain spaces for patient triage, laboratory tests, and private treatment. Medical Bridges, a BUILD partner in Houston, fills each clinic with medical equipment and consumable supplies before shipment. Partnering NGOs transform the clinic into access points for vaccinations, preventative medicine, and specialty care. Ultimately, these clinics alleviate present and future healthcare inequalities in the developing world.
