



Financial Statements



What are statements?

Financial statements are detailed summaries of the transactions processed in an account over a specific timeframe. They are designed to assist your student organizations manage, track, and reconcile organization funds.



Where are statements?

- Log into getinvolved.tamu.edu using your NetID
- Click the Admin tab at the top right-hand corner
- Click the Finances tab in the left-side menu panel



Understanding your statement:

- Finances will be divided into monthly statements with the current month-to-date transactions at the top.
- Transactions and up-to-date account balance will be updated at the end of each business day.
- Statements are divided into income, expenses, and outstanding items.
- Each section is organized by date, category, reference number, description, and amount.

Blue Text

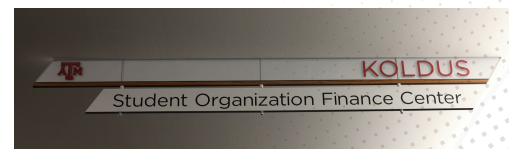
Anything in your statement colored blue means that there are multiple items or more details. Click the **blue** text to expand.
